George Hardin, who resides two miles southeast of Homer, died Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from a complication of troubles. He was forty-five years old. The funeral services were held Monday forenoon at 10 o'clock at Olive Branch church, Rev. J. H. Colwell preaching the sermon. The remains were interred in Davis cemetery. The deceased carried \$5,000 life insurance, his four children being the beneficiaries.
