

Mrs. Hess Dies at Rose Home

Mrs. William S. Hess, of Homer, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. F. M. Rose, 408 North Willis street, at 12 o'clock, noon, Tuesday. The exact cause of the death was not learned, but Mrs. Hess had been ill for the past two weeks. Ten days ago she was brought from Homer to this city for treatment, but her condition gradually grew worse.

Mrs. Hess was quite well known in the community where she lived, as she was also in this city, where she had visited on numerous occasions. She was 57 years of age. She had lived nearly all her life in Homer.

The deceased is survived by her husband, William S. Hess, of Homer; one son, Howard Hess, also of Homer, and one daughter, Mrs. F. M. Rose, 408 North Willis street.

The funeral services will be held at 3:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the late home in Homer.
